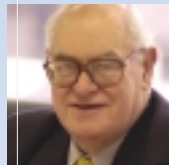

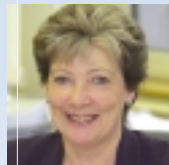

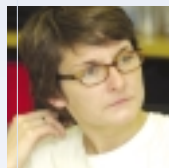

previously Leader of the House of Lords, EEC Commissioner, Member of Parliament and UK Ambassador to the United Nations.



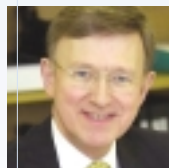
**Eira Davies**

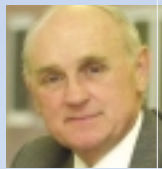


**Professor Laura McAllister**  
Professor of Governance, School of Management, University of Liverpool. From Bridgend.

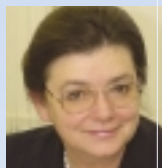


**Peter Price**

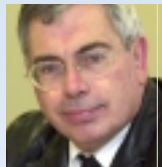
**Ted Rowlands**

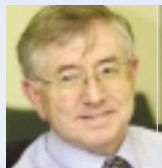
**Viv Sugar**  
Local Government Consultant and Chair of the Welsh Consumer Council. Former Chief Executive of the City and County of Swansea. Lives in Swansea.



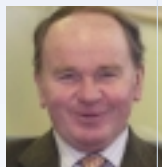
**Huw Thomas**
